## Supporting Needs of Dogs Under One Year

To comply with the Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities involving Animals) Regulations 2018, we have policies and procedures in place for dogs under one year. We work with them to support their development needs and welfare and document our process.

<b>Action</b>	<b>Procedure</b>
Accommodation in appropriate area	We allow young dogs down time to nap, rest and process the day.
Regular interaction with staff	Extra interaction and play with staff and more attendance to play, toileting and resting needs.
Teach interaction with other dogs	Young dogs are introduced gradually do its not a negative experience for the dogs. We pride ourselves on allowing dogs of all breeds to mix so they don't become scared of dogs of other sizes.
Teach interaction with other species (if appropriate)	Introduction to horses and observation of cattle from our grounds.
Males under a year	Males under 12 months we allow still entire. But if they persist to either mount, dominate or pester other dogs, then we cannot have them until they've been castrated.
