NEW DOG ATTENDING PROCEDURE

- Dog would have already been assessed before attending
- On dogs first day of daycare, they will be brought into the front paddock for lead work, mental stimulation and adjusting to the environment as it can be quite daunting for the dog when the owner leaves.
- We take the dog up to the fence to sniff the pack with distance and barrier there in case of a negative interaction.
- Once the dog has adjusting and body language is feeling more comfortable within the
 environment. We bring out a couple of dogs into the front paddock. These dogs are
 selected if they are showing a calm and social interest in the new dog, and the new
 dog is showing a respectful interest in the selected dogs.
- Once the new dog has got familiar to the ones already selected, we open the gates up and the rest of the pack will come out. This is very monitored and we make sure the dogs show nothing but respect and space to the new dog coming in.
- The new dog will be kept on lead while investigating the further paddocks and taking in the scents, allowing them to go toilet if they feel comfortable in the environment enough to.
- If the dog is showing respectful social behaviour, they will be put on a long line to asses they behaviour with further freedom.
- When the dog shows social interaction / play then we let them off lead and monitor the interaction with the pack.
